The first multidisciplinary conference in Paris marked the **creation of the network in 1984**, which has grown progressively denser and now, 40 years later in 2024, includes around **500 correspondents** in some **twenty countries** (Australia, Austria, Belgium, Cameroon, Canada, Central Cameroon, Canada, Central African Republic, Czech Republic, Denmark, France, Germany, Japan, Niger, Netherlands, Nigeria, Russia, Switzerland, United Kingdom, United States, Nigeria, Netherlands, Russia, Switzerland, United Kingdom, Chad, Czech Republic, United States, etc.).

Its aims are to promote and support **multidisciplinary research into the societies and environments of the Lake Chad Basin, both past and present**, and to disseminate the results. As such, it disseminates scientific information via a website (<http://www.mega-tchad.net>) and a blog (<https://megatchad.wordpress.com>), a discussion list and a mailing list, publishes book reviews, compiles and edits a bibliography each year, and organises international colloquia, which are the high points of the network's activities.

18 symposia were held in various **European countries** (France, Germany, Netherlands, Italy) and **Africa** (Cameroon, Nigeria, Chad). For each conference, a small team of network members takes charge of the organisation and publication, after a rigorous selection of contributions. These conferences have all been published. The **North-South dialogue** is regularly stimulated in these colloquia, in which African researchers, among others, take part.

The XVIIIth Méga-Tchad international symposium was held for the first time in **N'Djamena**, from 29 to 31 January 2020, on the theme "Times of change. Ruptures and continuity in the Lake Chad Basin". It will be published by IRD Editions.
